

KGS BRAILLE LABELER

The KGS Braille Labeler allows you to make sturdy **transparent** labels on pre-cut adhesive-backed strips. You can add a short message in Braille to just about any surface without obscuring existing type or graphics. Add Braille to guests' hotel keys, vending machines, cassettes, CD cases, telephones and more—just about anywhere you need it.

You don't even have to know Braille to create labels that make objects in the environment much more user-friendly for Braille readers, because the Braille Labeler has its own built-in Braille translators. Grade 1 Braille (the simplest Braille code) is the default—or choose grade 2 Braille, which contains contractions to make common words shorter and is often used on signs and in books for adults.

How it works: To make a label, just choose individual letters, numbers, and punctuation marks from a small visual screen to spell out your message. You can back up and edit your message before you print it, even save your message in three "folders" in the Braille Labeler's memory for later use. When you're ready to print the label, the Braille Labeler will tell you how your message will fit on one of the three available label sizes. Insert the label and print.
