For several years, customers have urged us to build an embosser with **greater speed and capacity** for the growing Braille publishing industry. More emphasis on Braille in schools and workplaces means more books, menus, textbooks, and lessons to publish. That's great for Braille readers but Braille publishers often find themselves flooded with larger orders than their present equipment can comfortably handle.

BraillePlace can help, with its **serious productivity for serious Braille publishing**. A 45 character line and speeds of **300 characters per second** mean that BraillePlace embosses an interpoint page in record time.

If you can use a Romeo 25, our most basic embosser, you already know everything you need to work with BraillePlace. BraillePlace connects to any computer through its parallel and serial ports, and built-in ET Speaks automatically vocalizes BraillePlace's control settings, which are the same as all our other embossers. Even while echoing the commands you enter on BraillePlace's keypad, ET Speaks can still keep working as the voice of your DoubleTalk LT-compatible screen reader and play WAV and other audio files in DOS and Windows.

Plus, we've included Dynamic Braille Scaling, so you can choose different Braille sizes, and even a special Moon Type feature for publishers in the UK. And of course, BraillePlace will also produce regular and high-resolution Braille graphics.



BraillePlace is large—39 inches wide by 30 inches deep by 58 inches high (99.1 cm by 76.2 cm by 149.9 cm)—and it requires a 220 volt electric line. We also ask that BraillePlace customers send a mechanically inclined trusted staff member to our plant for some brief training on how to keep BraillePlace running at peak productivity and minimize inconvenient downtime. Braille Place is designed to be especially open and easy to work on with standard tools at your location.
